### **Uniform Reminders**

As the weather grows cooler please remember that if your child is cold in their classroom that they may wear a navy blue cardigan sweater (**NO HOODED SWEATERS**) that meets the uniform policy. All shirts worn underneath the uniform shirts should be a **solid white** – no prints or colors on under shirts. Students may wear a solid white turtleneck under their uniform shirt. The temperature of the classrooms will be between 68 and 70 degrees once the heating season begins.
