School Snow Closing Policy

Closings are announced on radio station **AM 620 WTMJ** or **TV station TMJ4** as well as **FOX 6, CBS 58 and WITI Channel 12**. St. Philip's is automatically closed if **Wisconsin Lutheran High School** is closed for snow or cold. Listen to the radio or TV! Teachers will also call their students if we have an accurate phone number for your child. We will also post to Facebook as well as send an email to all families. Once the school day has begun, classes will be conducted for the remainder of the school day except in the case of extreme emergency.

Winter Weather

Winter is here and it's cold! We do go outside for recess or a walk. Please remember to send the appropriate outdoor clothing with your children. This includes winter coats, hats, mittens and boots when necessary.

Health Reminders

A student who has the following symptoms should stay home:

- A temperature above 100.4 F,
- sore throat,
- a new, uncontrolled cough that causes difficulty in breathing,
- diarrhea, vomiting, or abdominal pain,
- new onset of severe headache, especially accompanied by a fever,
- loss of taste and/or smell.

These symptoms may not be indicative of COVID; however, the student should **stay home** for **at least two days** and be fever-free without fever-reducing medication for 24 hours and receive clearance from the school office to return.
