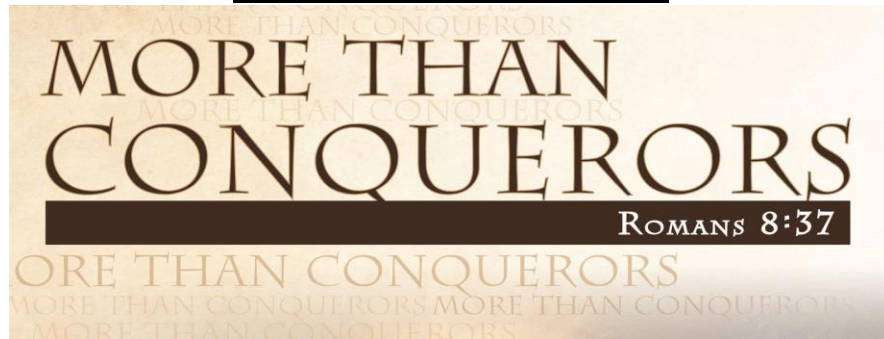

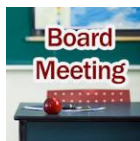

**LUNCH REMINDER:** Students may bring a small bag of chips, granola bar, fruit snacks, a sandwich or a piece of fruit to add to their hot lunch. ### **Uniform Reminders**

As the weather grows cooler please remember that if your child is cold in their classroom that they may wear a navy blue cardigan sweater (**NO HOODED SWEATERS or SWEATSHIRTS**) that meets the uniform policy. All shirts worn underneath the uniform shirts should be a **solid white or solid navy blue** – no prints or colors on under shirts. Students may wear a solid white or navy blue long sleeve shirt under their uniform shirt. The temperature of the classrooms will be between 68 and 70 degrees once the heating season begins.

### **Uniform Shorts**

**The last day to wear shorts until spring was September 30<sup>th</sup>.** No shorts should be worn to school again until May 1, 2022. Thank you.
