ADVENT WREATH

On the first Sunday of Advent, the prophecy candle is lit, in remembrance of the prophets, primarily Isaiah, who foretold the <u>birth of Christ</u>. This candle represents hope or expectation in anticipation of the coming Messiah.

On the second Sunday, an additional candle is lit. This candle typically represents love. Some traditions call this the Bethlehem candle, symbolizing Christ's manger.

On the third Sunday of Advent another candle is lit. This candle is customarily called the Shepherds' candle and it represents joy.

The fourth and last candle, often times called the Angel's candle, represents peace and is lit on the fourth Sunday of Advent.

CHRISTMAS DRESS DOWN DAY GUIDELINES

YES PLEASE:

- Students and staff are encouraged to wear a Christmas themed or "Ugly" holiday themed sweater with a pair of blue jeans or uniform pants.
- A homemade "ugly" sweater creation is highly encouraged so please do not worry, you can always make your own!

Students who choose not to participate in our Christmas theme dress down have the option to dress as they would on a regular Friday (SP "t-shirt" and blue jeans or regular school uniform).

The "Fine Print"

- All clothing should be appropriate for a Christian school environment. Do not wear anything that is offensive, derogatory, or disrespectful in any way to anyone else including, other students, families, staff, or to the community/society at large.
- Clothing should not be too tight, too loose, or revealing. Clothing should also be appropriate for the weather (classes go outside for recess).
- All student clothing choices should clearly show participation. SPLS reserves the right to require students to change their clothing if it is deemed inappropriate or not fitting with the Christmas/Holiday "Ugly Sweater" theme for the day.
- Failure to wear appropriate clothing may result in forfeiting participation in future dress down days: Friday, December 8th and 15th.
