2023-2024 School Year Enrollment Process

St. Philip's second open enrollment period will be from March 1–20, 2023.

We enrolled more than 75 students during the first open enrollment period.

DO NOT DELAY – ENROLL during this open enrollment to be assured of a seat for the 2023-2024 school year. New students may also enroll at this time. All parents must sign-up on-line and then wait for an email from DPI with instructions on how to complete your child or children's enrollment at St. Philip's Lutheran School.

St. Philip's is also participating in the Wisconsin Choice program for families living outside of the city of Milwaukee.

Open enrollment for that program runs from February 1, 2022, until Thursday, April 15, 2022.

**JUAN PABLO HORCASITAS
PIANIST AND MUSIC EDUCATOR**



Since his Carnegie Hall debut in 2009, he has been performing actively as a concert, collaborative pianist, and conductor. His recent performances include recitals in Asia, the Middle East, Europe, South America, Central America, Mexico, and the United States. He has been a soloist with many orchestras, including the Lebanese Philharmonic Orchestra, Chamber Orchestra of Singapore, Camerata de Coahuila, and Orquesta Sinfónica de Aguascalientes, among others.

He is also an active music educator. For many years he was a piano faculty at the Filomen M. D'Agostino Greenberg Music School - for the visually impaired and at the Diller-Quaile School of Music, both schools based in New York City. He holds both the Bachelor's and Master's in Piano Performance degrees from the Manhattan School of Music, where he studied with the legendary Russian pedagogue Nina Svetlanova. He also received formal conducting training under Maestro David Jackson's guidance at the Metropolitan Opera House in NYC. His teachers in Mexico include Alberto Cruzprietto and Ma. Teresa Frenk. He currently holds the Chair of the Piano Department and Piano Faculty Position at the Wisconsin Conservatory of Music. At the same time, he is pursuing his studies at the University of Wisconsin in Madison to obtain the Doctor of Musical Arts in Piano Performance degree under the guidance of Dr. Jessica Johnson.
