Health Reminders

A student who has the following symptoms should stay home:

- A temperature above 100.4 F,
- sore throat,
- a new, uncontrolled cough that causes difficulty in breathing,
- diarrhea, vomiting, or abdominal pain,
- new onset of severe headache, especially accompanied by a fever,
- loss of taste and/or smell.

These symptoms may not be indicative of COVID; however, the student should **stay home** for **at least two days** and be fever-free without fever-reducing medication for 24 hours and receive clearance from the school office to return.

2021-2022 School Year Enrollment Process

St. Philip's third open enrollment period will be from April 1–20, 2021.

We enrolled more than 80 students during the first two enrollment periods.

DO NOT DELAY – ENROLL during this next open enrollment to be assured of a seat for the 2021-2022 school year.

New students may also enroll at this time. All parents must sign-up on-line and then wait for an email from DPI with instructions on how to complete your child or children's enrollment at St. Philip's Lutheran School.

St. Philip's is also participating in the Wisconsin Choice program for families living outside of the city of Milwaukee. Open enrollment for that program runs from February 1, 2021 until Thursday, April 15, 2021.
