Singing in church is part of your child’s music grade. If your child cannot make it please talk to their teacher before each date so it will not affect their participation grade for music.



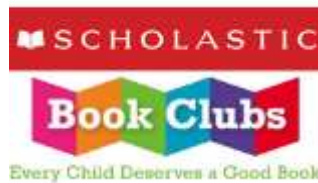
